DR. VLADIMIR PETROCI

Slovak Academy of Classical Homeopathy

Dr. Vladimír Petroci, born in 1965 in Levoča, Slovakia, graduated in medicine and worked as a pulmonologist for 12 years. He began studying homeopathy in 1991 and has been teaching and organizing seminars on homeopathy since 1997.

In 2004, he founded the Slovak Academy of Classical Homeopathy in Bratislava. The academy now has branches in Slovakia, Poland, and the Czech Republic. Its curriculum emphasizes a systemic approach to studying materia medica. In addition to core seminars, the academy offers specialized seminars taught by renowned homeopaths, which are open to an international audience.

He is a co-founder and the current president of the Slovak Chamber of Homeopaths. Dr. Petroci is also a translator and publisher of homeopathic books by modern authors. He authored the book *Studánky*, which has been published in Czech and French.

Additionally, he is a co-founder of the Quintessence Forum, a movement aimed at fostering the emergence of a new paradigm, particularly within the homeopathic community.
